The exhibition in the Medieval Tower is a sensory experience that allows visitors to explore the life of the monarch at the Tower of London and the busy world of the medieval court using sight, touch, sound and smell to bring to life the intimate spaces where Medieval kings dined, slept, played and prayed.

This visitor is taken on a journey back in time and walks in the footsteps of the Kings who inhabited this part of the palace. The exhibition includes audio visual programmes, graphics panels, smells and soundscapes.
